**GADDS' No 3**  
Premium Pale Ale  
5.0%

Colour gold  
Bitterness high  
Sweetness low

The true taste of East Kent, this pale ale is brewed simply with pale malt and goldings hops grown on Humphrey's farm, just down the road. It's fresh, hoppy, clean and bitter.



**GADDS' DogBolter**  
Dark Porter  
5.6%

Colour very dark  
Bitterness high  
Sweetness medium

This sturdy dark porter is brewed with six different malts for a satisfying, rich, malty body full of roasty, chocolatey flavours all a balanced by a deep and lasting hop bitterness. This one hits the spot like no other.



**GADDS' Seaside**  
Amber Ale  
4.3%

Colour tangerine  
Bitterness medium  
Sweetness medium/high

A mellow, easy drinking ale brewed with a little crystal malt and a lot of goldings hops. Nothing flash, just a very decent malty body and a balancing hop flavour.



**GADDS' No 5**  
Best Bitter Ale  
4.4%

Colour ruby  
Bitterness medium/high  
Sweetness medium

A traditional Kentish Best bitter - the aroma is toffee malt and fresh green hops, the flavour is malt, hops and red berries with a full body and lingering bitter finish. Yeh.



**GADDS' No 7**  
Pale Bitter Ale  
3.8%

Colour pale copper  
Bitterness medium  
Sweetness low

The brewery workhorse. A simple beer brewed with goldings hops for a little bitterness, fuggles hops for flavour and some crystal malt for colour and body. Nice 'n' easy, drinks lovely.



**GADDS' Black Pearl**  
Oyster Stout  
6.2%

Colour bible-black  
Bitterness medium  
Sweetness medium

Roasted barley, malted oats and Kent grown Fuggles hops combine to create this luscious, bible-black stout specially brewed to compliment the gorgeous seafood at Eddie Gilbert's Fish Monger \*Gourmet Fish & Chips \*Restaurant.

Lois & I (*Eddie*) set up this brewing business in the back of a smoky seafront boozier in 2002, trying our hardest to deliver really fresh, tasty, local beer to the pubs of East Kent. We eventually expanded production in 2006, when we moved into our own building, and again in 2010, when we built a new brewery. And with the help of our dear friends, the East Cliff Miscreants (and the Fancy West Cliffer), we've grown the business beyond all recognition. But though we've come a long way, we're still local, with over 90% of our beer being sold on draught in local East Kent pubs.
